

These sheets list what The Highland Council does, and they may not include everything.

They been categorised to help us understand what is a statutory function and what is not, and what degree of control the Council has in what is delivered, how and with what budget. The sheets help to describe what we do, and will form part of the foundation work for considering what, why and how we do things in the future.

The down arrows indicate where budgets have already been reduced for these functions in the last budget decisions.

Currently the Redesign Board is considering the lists to help them be clear about the Council's purpose and outcomes. They will be looking at all functions to identify where to seek further information for future phases of the Board's work - no function is currently out of scope. Many of the functions on the red sheet are support services which help the statutory functions to be provided, and these are not the only functions being considered as part of the redesign.
