ORDER TO EXEMPT LAND FROM ACCESS RIGHTS

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (Fyrish Path & Car Park, Novar Estate) ORDER 2024

The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Section 11 (1) of the Land Reform (Scotland) Act 2003 ("the Act") hereby make the following Order: -

- This Order may be cited as "The Highland Council (Fyrish Path & Car Park, Novar Estate)) Order 2024", and shall come into operation at 0700hrs on Thursday 23rd May 2024 until 2100hrs on Friday 24th May 2024 and from 0700 hrs until 2100hrs on Monday 17th June 2024, unless revoked earlier.
- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. The effect of the Order is to exempt land, namely the car park, the main path towards the Fyrish Monument, the area around the monument and two wider tracks to the west of the main path, shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and signed as relative to this Order, from the access rights which would otherwise be exercisable in respect of that land by virtue of Part 1 of the Act. Rights of way are not affected by this Order.
