The Community Council have agreed to submit the application,</li> <li>Group prepared an application to the SFA (Scottish Football Association) grassroots fund, as suggested by the SFA, only to discover that the fund had been closed. Had a follow up meeting with the SFA on Tuesday. The fund had closed as a couple of big projects which had looked doubtful did go ahead using up the rest of the fund. They don't know when the fund will be re-opened as this is dependent on the result of the UK election. SFA suggested we develop a strong business plan in readiness for the next round opening.</li> <li>Have identified funds of £165,500 from LSHA, Sleat &amp; Strath FC &amp; the Youth Club to be used as match funding for phase 1 (the astro pitch) against any funding bids. This is an excellent start.</li> <li>Bank accounts are open and ready to receive any donations.</li> <li>JF – Really disappointing about SFA funding. Need to go back to Sport Scotland for funding.</li> <li>RC – Have a meeting next week with Graham Sutherland (Regional Manager North) from SFA. Will seek an update from him.</li> </ul> | RC |
