Is my project eligible for this fund?

You must be able to answer Yes to <u>all</u> the questions relevant to your project below before you submit an application for this fund.

- Is your project within the Highland Council area of operation?
- Is your project located within a rural setting? (Inverness city projects and projects located in Badenoch & Strathspey are not eligible for this fund)
- Is the project lead a constituted group or registered charity/community group? (businesses and individuals are not eligible for this fund)
- Is the total grant request amount at least £5,000?
- Is the total grant request amount £25,000 or under?
- Are your project costs based on quotes that will be valid at least until the end of September 24? (The deadline for submitting valid quotes is 14th August. Please note we do not need to have valid quotes by the application submission deadline of 17th July but we must have received them by 14th August)
- If your project funding package includes match funding from other sources, is all your match funding confirmed?
- If your application is successful, will your project be completed and the grant claimed by 28th February 25?
- If your project requires statutory permissions, such as planning, building warrant, marine licence, etc. are these permissions in place and can you provide evidence of this alongside the application form?
- Do you own the asset or do you have a valid and current lease agreement in place?
 This evidence must be provided alongside the application form.

If you cannot answer Yes to <u>all</u> the questions above, your project is likely to be ineligible, please contact a member of the Community Regeneration Funding team at <u>communityregeneratiofund@highland.gov.uk</u> if you wish to discuss eligibility.
