

**THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (FOUNDRY WAY, INVERNESS) (ONE WAY)
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2024**

Statement of Reasons

The Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 proposes to create a controlled route for public transport vehicles to exit Farraline Park Bus Station in one direction only. The purpose of this is to facilitate the passage of buses, taxis and bicycles on a one-way street constructed for this purpose.

THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL

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The Highland Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and 2(2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended and of all the other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the said Act hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order may be cited as “The Highland Council (Foundry Way, Inverness) (One Way) Traffic Regulation Order 2024” and shall come into operation on *****
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. All provisions contained in any order, enactment, or others in so far as the same repeat or are inconsistent with the provisions of this Order and true intent and meaning hereof shall cease to have effect and are hereby revoked.
4. Subject to Article 5 of this Order, no person shall drive or cause or permit any vehicle to be driven on the lengths of road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule 1 annexed and signed as relative hereto other than in the direction specified opposite in Column 2 of the said Schedule.
5. Pedal cycles are exempt from the restrictions detailed in Article 4 of this Order.

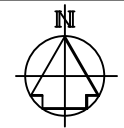
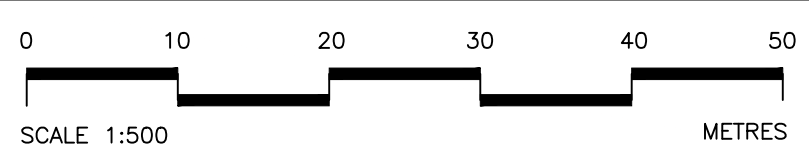
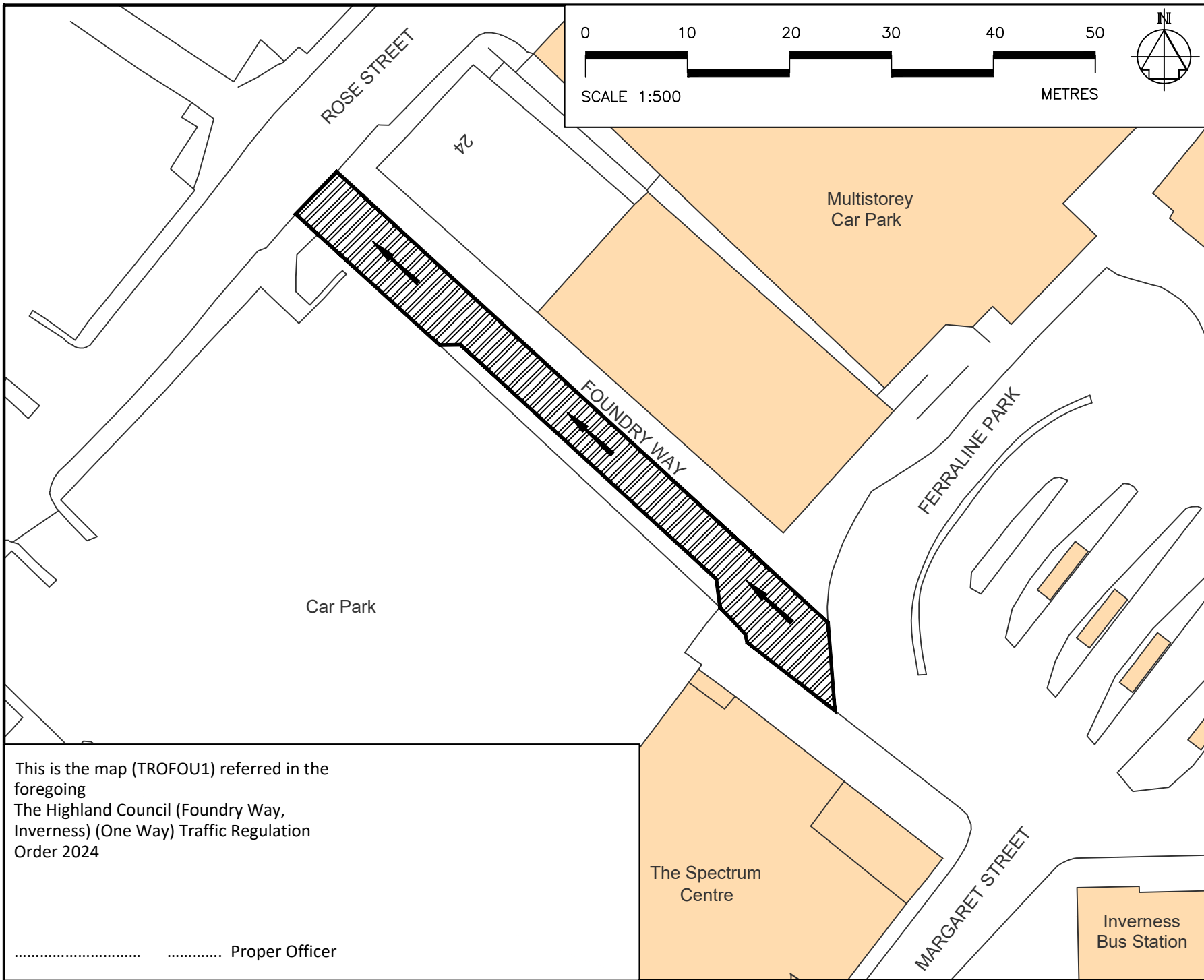
ONE WAY STREET
