

## **THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL (CANNICH BRIDGE TO RIVER GLASS BRIDGE) (30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2024**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Highland Council proposes to make an Order in terms of Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 entitled as above.

If the Order comes into force, the Order will introduce a 30mph speed limit on the following roads in Cannich over their entire length, unless stated otherwise below:

A831 Drumnadrochit - Cannich – Beauly Toll Road. From its northernmost junction with the C1110 Cannich - Fasnakyle - Kerrow Wood Road, and extending to a point 870 metres or thereby south-east of said junction; U2817 Bencharin View (Beinn A Chairein View).

A copy of the proposed Order, together with a copy of the relevant plan, the Authority's Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order along with the The Highland Council Cannich, A831 Drumnadrochit - Cannich/Beauly Road) (40mph Speed Limit) And (C30 Cannich - Fasnakyle - Kerrow Road) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 1999, which will be revoked in part if the proposed order comes into force can be inspected at the Inverness Service Point, Town House, Castle Street, Inverness, IV1 1JJ during normal opening hours from Monday to Friday 10:00 – 12:30 and 1:30 to 4:30, from the 11<sup>th</sup> October 2024 to the 8<sup>th</sup> November 2024.
