THE HIGHLAND COUNCIL PROPOSE TO EXTEND A RAISED TABLE ON U1846 SMITHTON PARK, SMITHTON - INVERNESS

Statement of Reasons

The Highland Council aim to promote the safe and efficient use of the roads they are responsible for. Where these roads link towns, villages and cities, there are frequently competing pressures between their strategic purpose, and community interests relating to safety and amenity.

In the interests of road safety and casualty reduction and the furtherance of Council policy to promote road safety on its road network, it is proposed to extend an existing raised table on a section of the U1846, Smithton Park from 19 metres to 21 metres or thereby Northwest of Murray Road (U1843), Smithton, which will be consistent with other similar routes and is appropriate to the function and nature of the road.
