The Heat Map is made up of 5 themes, each one containing a number of theme related layers of information:

- Heat Demand
- Potential Heat Supply
- Skills/ Technology
- Opportunities/ Constraints
- Context

The map can be used at any scale and as the starting point for more complex analyses of potential renewable heat opportunities.
