#### 1. Annual Report

- 1.1 Appendix I of this report shows the Income and Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet in respect of the Cromarty Common Good Fund for Financial Year 2012/13.
- 1.2 Members are requested to note Common Good grants awarded totalling £2,860 (itemised in Note One Grants Awarded).
- 1.3 In the accounts the classification of all non current assets is subject to a de minimus level of £0.006m for vehicles and plant and machinery and £0.020m for all other assets. Consequently some assets belonging to the Common Good, with a relatively smaller value are not included in the figure reported in the accounts.
- 1.4 Members will note that the £43,500 investment properties figure shows a reduction of £5,000 from the previous year. This is due to a revaluation of property.
