1. PROPOSAL

- 1.1 This application seeks permission to erect two polytunnels. The polytunnels will measure 4.267m wide x 6.096m long x 2.286m high and will be covered in a translucent white material.
- 1.2 The polytunnels will be used as part of a community growing project.

2. SITE DESCRIPTION

2.1 The site is part of the playground at Hilton of Cadboll Primary School. The polytunnels will be erected next to the school building. The site is already laid out with paving slabs as shown on the plan.




