Street naming – New development at Milton of Leys, Inverness

Report by Director of Planning and Development

Summary

The Committee is asked to homologate a decision by the Community Council, supported by the local Members, to name a street that currently has built units and a primary school taking access from it as 'Leys Square' (*Ceàrnag an Leighis*).

1. Background

- 1.1 The Council's Corporate Address Gazetteer (CAG) Team within the Planning and Development Service was asked by the developers who were building a retail unit at Milton of Leys near the primary school, to create an address for the new property.

2. Consultations

- 2.1 The CAG Team determined that there should be a street name. A request was sent to the Ward Manager to consult with the Community Council and local Members who all agreed that the street be called 'Leys Square' (*Ceàrnag an Leighis*).

3. Delegation to City/Area Committees

- 3.1 As per the new Scheme of Delegation the final decision on Street and Building Naming is delegated to the Area/City Committees. However in this instance the property was being handed over to customers on 5 December. We therefore had to act on what had been agreed with the Community Council and local Members and bring the matter to the Area Committee for homologation.

4. Implications

The Area Committee is invited to homologate the naming of the street at Milton of Leys as 'Leys Square'.
