**Street naming – Development in Broadford**

**Report by Head of Policy and Reform**

### **Summary**

The Area Committee is asked to homologate the naming of a flatted development at Harrapool in Broadford, Isle of Skye as Old School Square.

## **1. Background**

- 1.1 The Council's Corporate Address Gazetteer (CAG) Team within the Development and Infrastructure Service was asked to create an address by the developers for a 12 Flat development at Harrapool in Broadford, Isle of Skye.

No suggestions were put forward by the developers.

## **2. Consultations**

- 2.1 A request was sent to the Ward Manager to consult with the Broadford and Strath Community Council and Local Members.

- 2.2 Broadford and Strath Community Council put forward the name Old School Square.

After consultation with Local Members all the Members supported the proposed name put forward by the Community Council.

The Ward Business Meeting held on the 5 October, 2015 therefore approved Old School Square as the name for the development. The Gaelic translation for the agreed name being Ceàrnag na Seann Sgoile

## **3. Delegation to Area Committee**

- 3.1 As per the scheme of Delegation the final decision on Street and Building Naming is delegated to the Area/City Committees. However, as the property requires an address to allow the installing of services, the naming request was considered as a matter of urgency and was brought before Ward Members, resulting in this report coming to the Area Committee for homologation.
