Street naming – Development at Broadford, Skye

Summary

The Committee is asked to determine the name for a new development of 11 flats and 1 retail unit in Broadford, Skye as Strath House.

1. Background

- 1.1 The Council's Corporate Address Gazetteer (CAG) Team within the Development & Infrastructure Service was asked to create an address by the developers for an 11 Flat and 1 retail unit development in Broadford, Skye.
- No suggestions were put forward by the developers.

2. Consultations

- 2.1 A request was sent to the Ward Manager to consult with the Broadford & Strath Community Council and Local Members.
- 2.2 Broadford & Strath Community Council discussed the naming of the development at their meeting held on 17th February and have proposed the name Strath House.
