### **1. Purpose/Executive Summary**

**1.1** This report asks Members to homologate the street name of a new development in Alness.

### **2. Recommendations**

**2.2** Members are asked to:

- homologate the name of the new development in Alness as Dr Stewart Campbell Court.

### **3. Proposed Street Name**

- 3.1 A new street name is required for a new development of 16 properties in Alness.
- 3.2 Under the scheme of delegation the naming of new buildings and streets within the Council's control falls within the remit of the Ross and Cromarty Committee.
- 3.3 This development by Carbon Dynamics for Albyn Housing Society Ltd uses advanced, innovative technology to create homes which are flexible and suitable for people with a range of changing needs. A name was requested urgently as due to the technical nature of some features included services were required at an earlier stage than is usual.
- 3.4 Local Members proposed that the development be called 'Dr Stewart Campbell Court' to reflect the focus on health and wellness. Dr Campbell is a local resident who, as well as having served the community as a local GP for many years, also has a long history of voluntary work in the community with a focus on healthy living. Alness Community Council, Albyn Housing Society Ltd and Carbon Dynamics have all confirmed their support for this name.
