Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report is the second of 5 annual capital reports to be presented at this Council Area Committee over the life of the Capital Programme for 2018/19 to 2022/23.
- 1.2 The report shows for the Ross and Cromarty Council Area: the budget by capital project for 2019/20; the net expenditure by project in 2018/19 and the cumulative spend on each project in years 2018/19 and 2019/20 to end of June.

2. Implications

- 2.1 Resource the projects reported here are part of the overall Council Capital Programme for 2018/19 to 2022/23 and the required resource planning has been considered for the programme as a whole. The report presented here is for noting and therefore no further Resource implications arise.
- 2.2 Legal no specific implications.
- 2.3 Community (Equality, Poverty and Rural) no specific implications.
- 2.4 Climate Change / Carbon Clever no specific implications.
- 2.5 Risk The overall plan will be reviewed to ensure it continues to be affordable.
- 2.6 Gaelic no specific implications.

- 3.1 Members are asked to:
 - i. Note the expenditure on each project in this Council area in 2018/19.
 - ii. Note the budget for each project in this Council area in 2019/20.
 - iii. Note the cumulative spend for each project in this Council area for 2018/19 and 2019/20 to end of June.

4. Capital Programme

- 4.1 The Council's capital programme for 2018/19 to 2022/23 was agreed at Council on 7 March 2018. It was agreed a supplementary report should be prepared to show the total capital funding proposed for projects taking place in the district served by each Area Committee, with a follow-up end of year summary detailing the actual spend in each Area, and that this process should be continued annually over the 5 year term of the new Capital Budget to show also the cumulative year-on-year actual spend incurred in each Area.
- 4.2 The projects included in the report at Appendix 1 are all delivered within this Council area.

5. Capital Expenditure

- 5.1 On appendix 1, the "prior year actuals" column shows how much was spent on these projects in financial year 2018/19.
- 5.2 For the first time Cumulative Spend column is also included in this report and shows the total net expenditure on the project from April 2018 to end of June 2019.

6. Capital Budgets

- 6.1 The Capital budgets shown on the Appendix for 2019/20 derive from the Council Capital Programme which was agreed in March 2018.
- 6.2 The project budget figure reported here also includes any carry forward slippage from earlier years.
- 6.3 The budgets are not reflective of the Care and Learning investment as agreed at June 2019 Council. Also additional spend may occur during the year, funded from generic budgets e.g. energy management.

7. Projects

7.1 Officers managing the delivery of the projects on this list have provided additional detail and contextual information as follows:

Care and Learning Projects

7.2 Family Resource Centre, Dingwall Fire Station – tenders returned and awaiting approval. Issue with withdrawal of SFRS funding contribution.

Howard Doris Centre kitchen refurbishment – works progressing well, due to be complete end of August.

Ullapool PS replacement nursery – works progressing on site, due to be complete in October.

Hilton of Cadboll disabled access – some internal works progressing in summer hols, lift being installed in October.

Tarradale classroom unit – unit now on site, due to be complete mid August.

Community Services Projects

7.3 The delivery of the Roads Maintenance Programme for 19/20 is proceeding. The Programme was approved by the Ross and Cromarty Area Committee on 30 January 2019, and can be accessed on the following web-link: https://www.highland.gov.uk/meetings/meeting/4077/ross_and_cromarty_committee

Development and Infrastructure Projects

7.4 **River Peffery Flood Protection Scheme/Natural Flood Management Study** – Study ongoing to establish a preferred option for alleviation of flooding in Dingwall. Expected to have an Options Appraisal Report available by December 2019 for consideration by SEPA in their national scheme prioritisation exercise. The ground investigation is required later this financial year, with some minor external funding obtained from SEPA WEF (Water Environment Fund) for additional ecological surveys. The recent flooding incident in Dingwall is being reviewed and will be considered as further information in the options appraisal prior to finalisation.

Conon Bridge Flood Defence Improvements – land negotiations are nearing completion and detailed design has commenced. A ground investigation will be undertaken in the coming months to establish the seepage limits to influence the design.

Muir of Ord Railway Bridge – Works complete – ongoing issues with the contractor regarding landscape obligations.

Kinnairdie Link Road – No longer included in the capital programme, noting development infrastructure see below – designs are ongoing to unlock the current moratorium on housing development. Note traffic modelling has indicated that Kinnairdie Link will be required to unlock all the housing contained in the local plan.

Stromeferry – stabilisation works on the existing slopes is programmed to commence in September for completion by November – following extensive public consultations. Night time closures with the significant diversion will be required over night for the duration of the works. The contract will also include the ground investigation needed to design the two other remaining very high risk slopes.

A832 Slattadale Widening – Works complete.

A890 Strathcarron Widening – Works complete

A890 Stromeferry Bypass - Cross Party working group has met with the regard to the recommendation on the long term solution – work is ongoing to prepare the material for the next working group meeting.

Newhall Bridge – Lifeline Bridges – Works complete.

A890 Balnacra to Lair – No longer included in the capital programme.

A832 Slattadale to Kerrysdale - No longer included in the capital programme.

Development Infrastructure Dingwall – Traffic modelling has identified that with traffic interventions housing moratorium can be released. Mart Road Junction traffic signals to be modified to link with County Buildings junction has been commissioned and will be undertaken in the near future. Tenders will be invited for Bridgend Junction – note Network Rail have been consulted and have no issues with the progression of these works.

Crask Junction Improvements – Works are ongoing.

Property

Salix funded works – Gairloch HS and Plockton HS currently being surveyed. Ullapool HS out for pricing and design.

Ullapool Service Point - New co-located Service Point with Library Service in McPhail Centre, Ullapool. Works now completed, involved exiting a lease and releasing space for re-use by NHSH to expand local healthcare facilities/provision in Ullapool.

Dingwall Property Rationalisation - New co-located Service Point within Dingwall Council offices co-located with back-office services. Works completed, involved the creation of a new Pest Control/Water Test lab and Corporate Satellite Records Store in Dingwall. Also released Ross House site for redevelopment for affordable housing units.

Plockton Hostel – fire suppression works progressing, due to be complete in September

Housing Projects

7.5 Further information on the Mainstream HRA Capital Programme is contained in the Quarterly Housing Performance being reported in a separate paper to this Committee.
