Report Title: Street Naming – Culbokie

1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report asks Members to homologate a street name for a new development of 12 properties in Culbokie.

3. Recommendations

- 3.1 Members are asked to homologate the name of Fowlers Croft for a new housing development within Culbokie.

4. Proposed Street name – Ward 9

- 4.1 A name was requested for a new housing development in Culbokie serving 12 properties. The developer proposed the name Harris Place however having considered this Ferintosh Community Council felt that 'Harris' had no local relevance. The Community Council proposed the alternative name of Fowlers Croft after a local family who had worked the site for many years and for which the area had also become commonly known. Ward 9 Members support the Community Council's proposal.

The development completion date was July 2019 therefore this name was required urgently to create the postal address hence this is before Members for homologation only.
