Response to Mr R MacWilliam

The Council has submitted two bids to the Scottish Government in respect of Brexit mitigation. The first bid was for £12.515 million which included money to support work around Export Health Certificates.

At the request of the Scottish Government, the Council then submitted a specific bid to cover Environmental Health Certificate demand. This bid was for £111,300 and notification was received on 28th November that the full amount of £111,300 has been awarded.
