1. Purpose/Executive Summary

1.1 This report sets out the current applications for grant funding over £10,000 to be determined.

2. Recommendations

- 2.1 Members are asked to:
 - i. Consider the applications for funding; and
 - ii. Note that the Grants Budget for 2019/20 has been fully allocated.
 - iii. Members are asked to note the changes in consideration of grant applications

3. Implications

- 3.1 Resource Funding is provided by the Inverness Common Good Fund budget for 2019/20. If approved the BID applications will be paid from the Partnership Working Budget for 2020/21.
- 3.2 Legal There are no Legal implications as a result of this report
- 3.3 Community (Equality, Poverty, Rural and Island) Applications are considered on merit which includes compliance with Council Policies. The need to ensure that the residents of the former Burgh of Inverness are the main beneficiaries is paramount.
- 3.4 Climate Change / Carbon Clever Consideration is given to ensuring that applications meet reasonable expectations in respect of climate change and carbon clever targets.
- 3.5 Risk There are no known risk implications in respect of this report.

4. Grant Applications

- 4.1 The current summary of funds available following the Inverness Common Good Fund Sub-Committee meeting on 3 February 2020 is set out in **Appendix 1**. Members are asked to note that the Grants Budget for 2019/20 has been fully allocated.
- 4.2 Following the Inverness Common Good Fund Sub-Committee meeting on the 3rd February Members are asked to note the following changes to the consideration of applications for financial assistance for a trail period of two years:
 - i. A budget of £75,000 will be put aside for grants under £5,000 these will be considered at all Inverness Common Good Fund Sub-Committee Meetings (4 per annum);
 - ii. Grants over £5,000 will be considered twice per annum and a budget of £100,000 will be allocated to each meeting. Recommendations will continue to be made to the City of Inverness Area Committee for Grants over £10,000.

The changes above will all be managed utilising the sums allocated to the Sub-Committee by the City Committee.
