1. Appointment of Chair

(i) Transport Review No 1/21

There had been circulated Report No 1/21 by the Senior Transport Officer providing information relating to a request to review a walking route to access home to school transport. The report gave details of the distances involved, the previous transport provision, entitlement arrangements and the risk assessment carried out. In conclusion it had made the recommendation that the route was considered suitable for walking.

The Senior Transport Officer having provided additional background information, there then followed a period of questioning of the officer by both the Members of the Sub Committee and Local Members present. At the conclusion of this, Local Members then put forward their views.

Following discussion, the Sub Committee **AGREED** that the road in question was not a suitable walking route and that the appeal be upheld.
