**Report Title:** Street Naming – Aviemore

### 1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report asks Members to agree the name for 1 street within a new Scotia Homes development in Aviemore which serves 75 properties over 4 new streets. The expected development completion date for this street is 3 November 2025.

#### **4. Proposed Street name – Ward 20**

- 4.1 Street names were requested for 4 new streets in a new housing development in Aviemore serving 75 properties. In accordance with the Street Naming Process, Aviemore & Vicinity Community Council were asked to propose names and at their meeting on 8<sup>th</sup> September proposed the following street names

Street 1 – Pink – Pityoulish Place

Street 2 – Brown – Farm Road

Street 3 – Green – Heather Lane

Street 4 – Blue – Pig Park Circus

Although the proposed street name for Street 4 has a local reference, the Ward 20 local Members have objected to this suggested name. Members are content with the names proposed for streets 1 to 3.

- 4.2 In the event that local Members do not agree with a suggested street name proposed by a Community Council, the Street Naming Process requires that the matter is brought to Area Committee for decision.
- 4.3 Committee is now asked to consider and agree a street name for Street 4 shown attached at Appendix 1.
