 - Fire safety audits

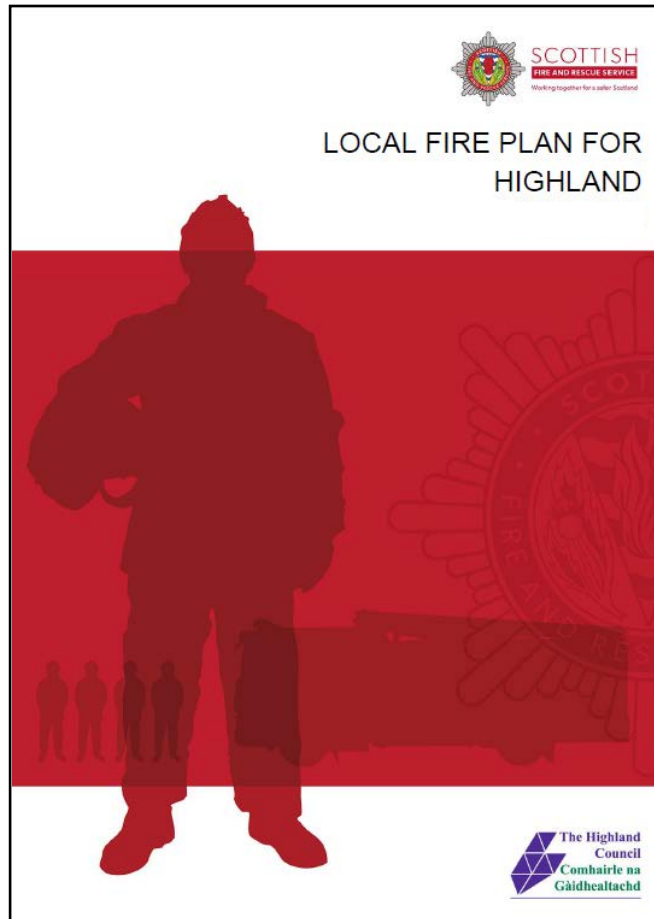

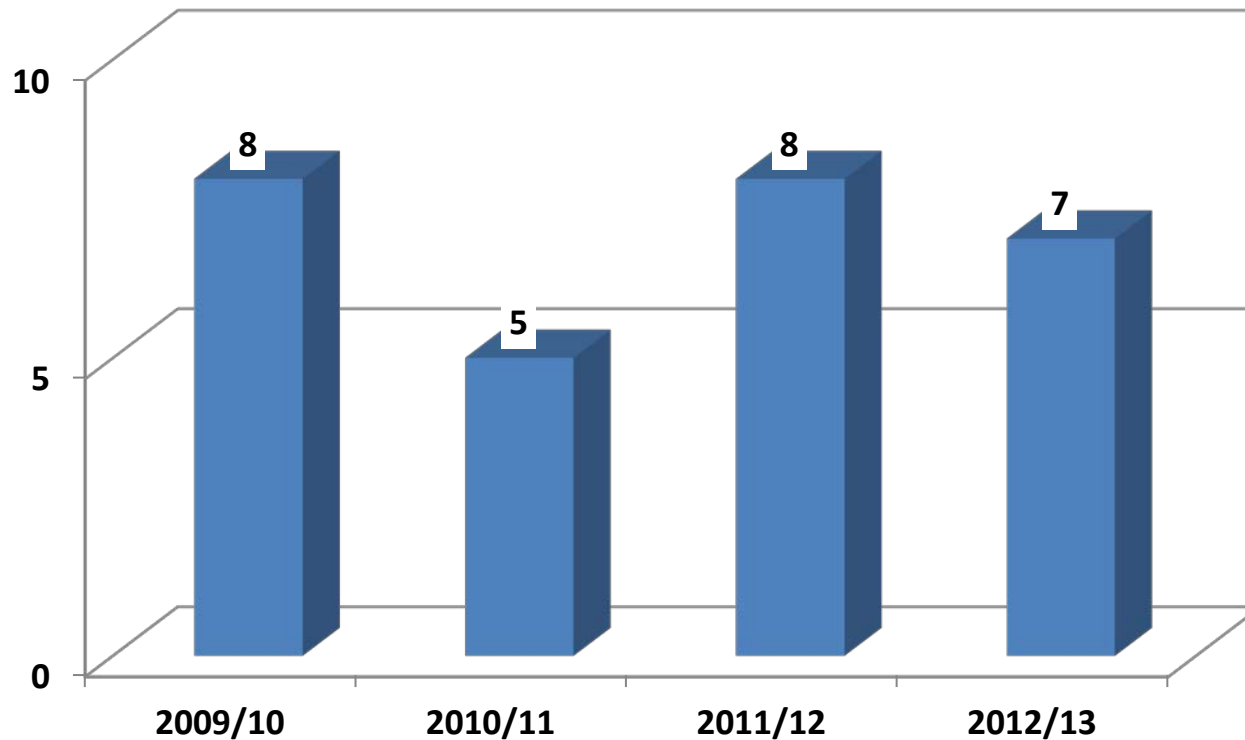

Accidental Dwelling Fires



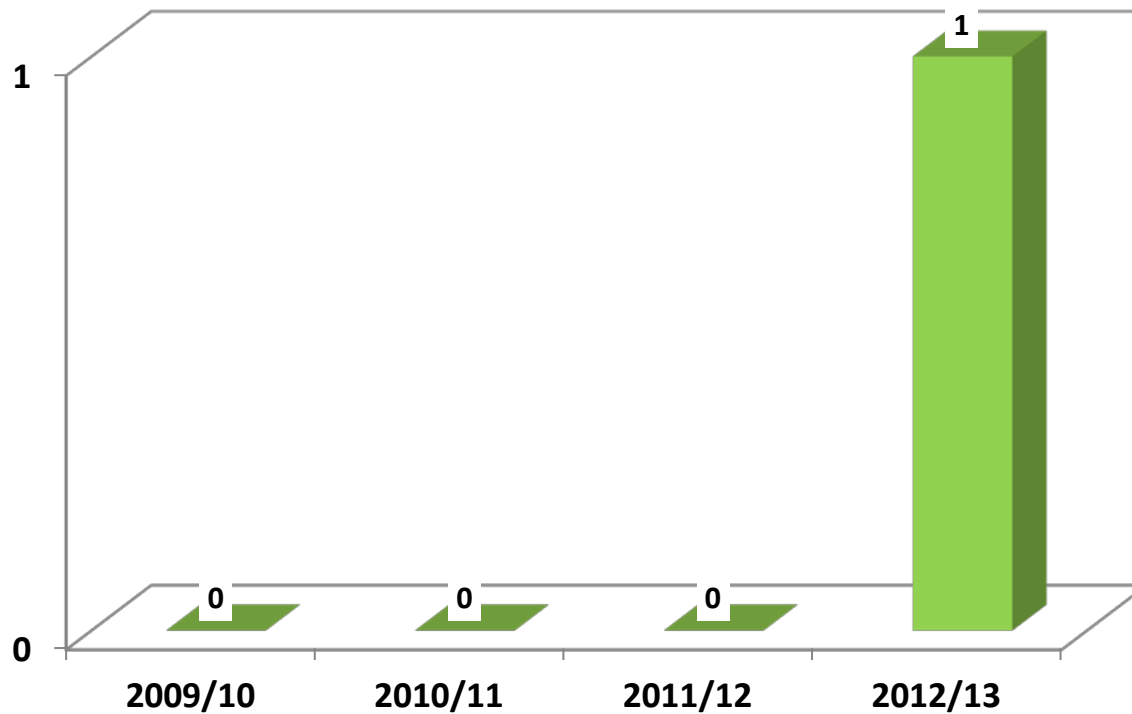

Fire Fatalities



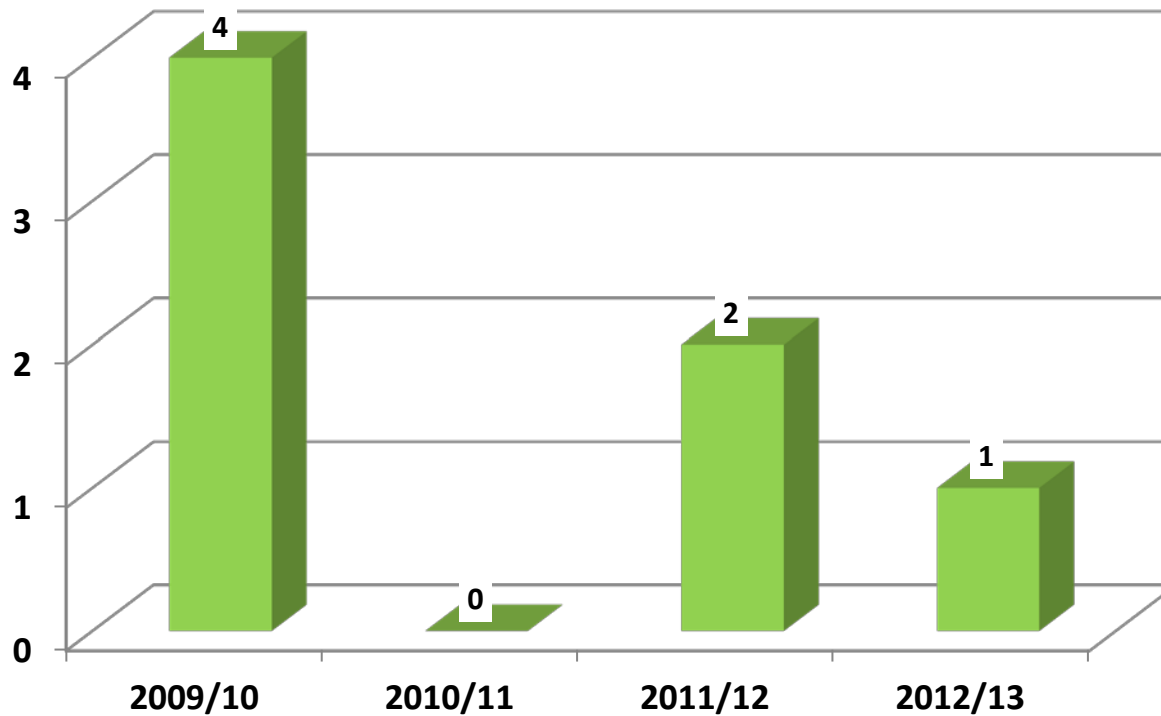

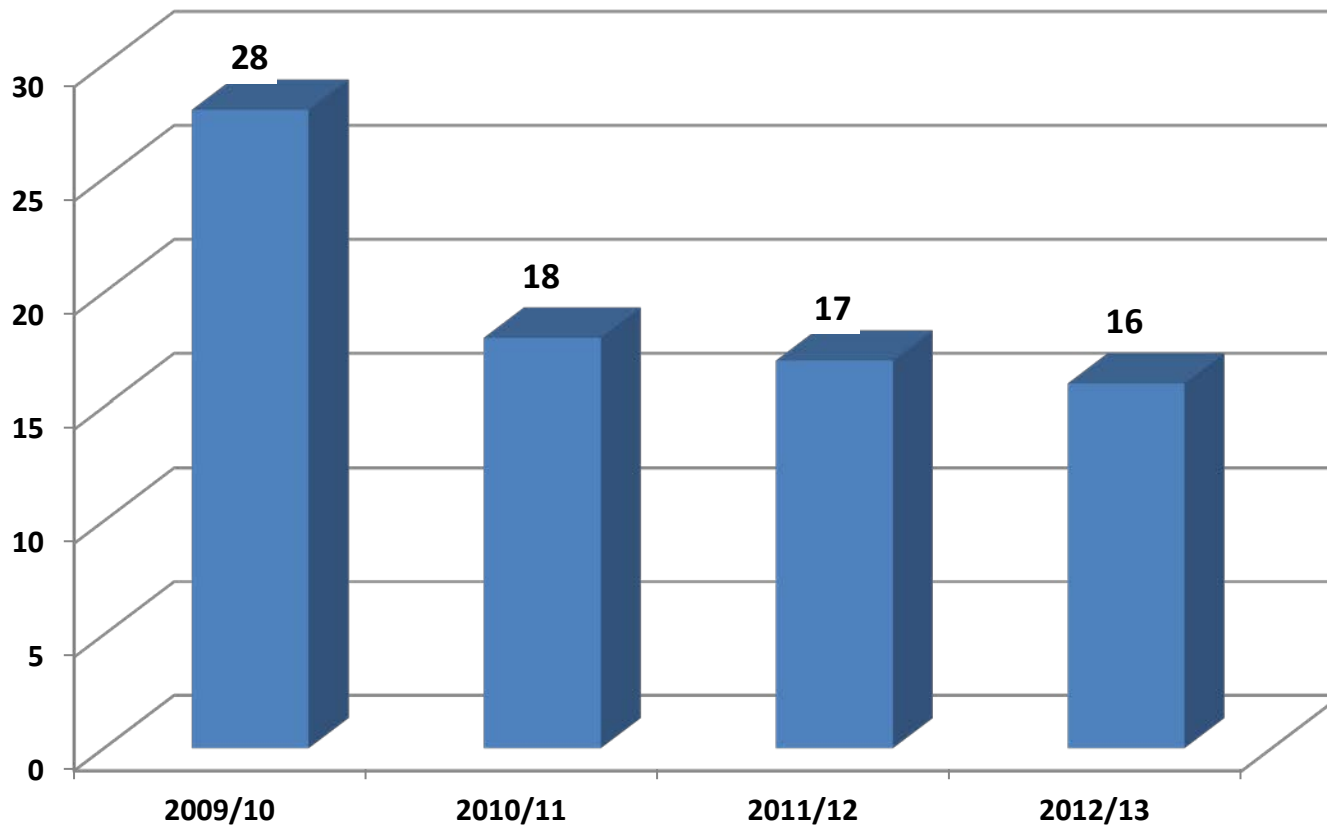

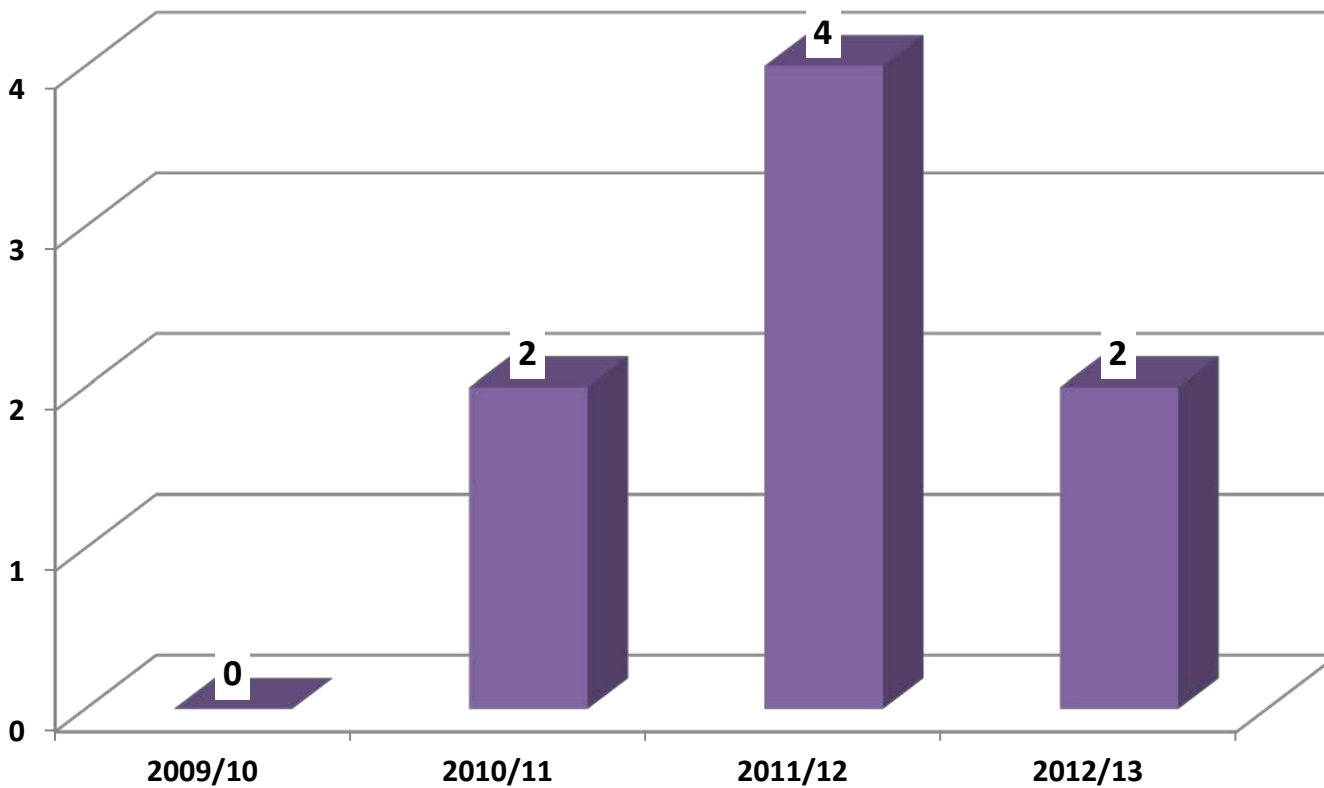

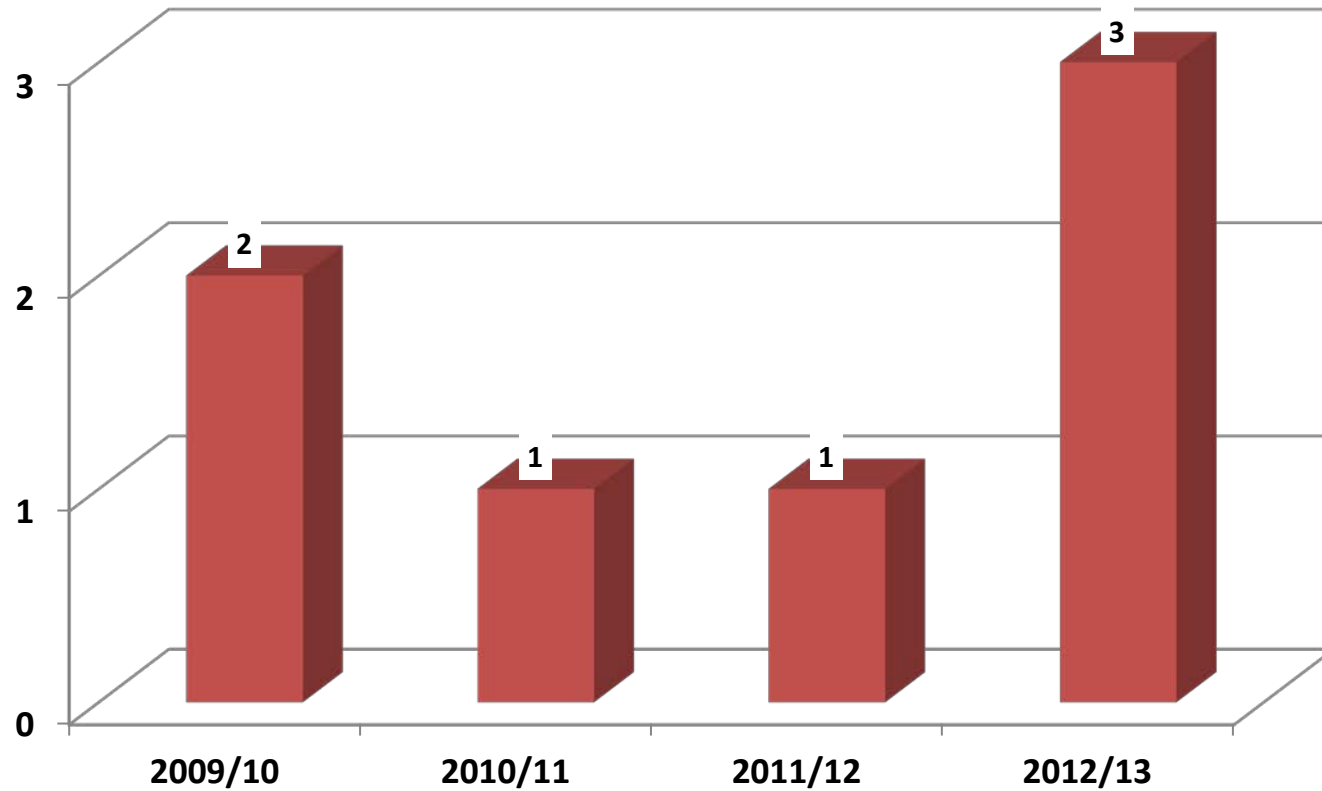

Road Traffic Collisions Attended by SFRS

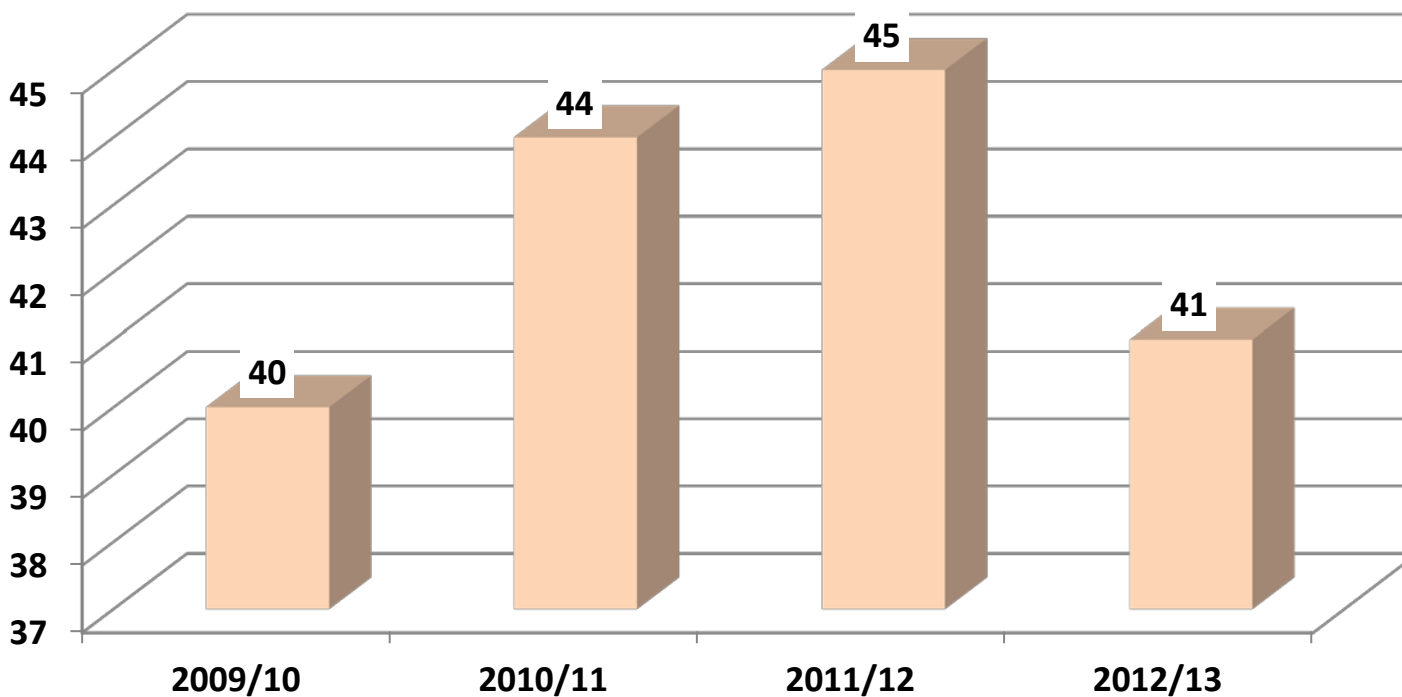

Automatic Fire Alarms



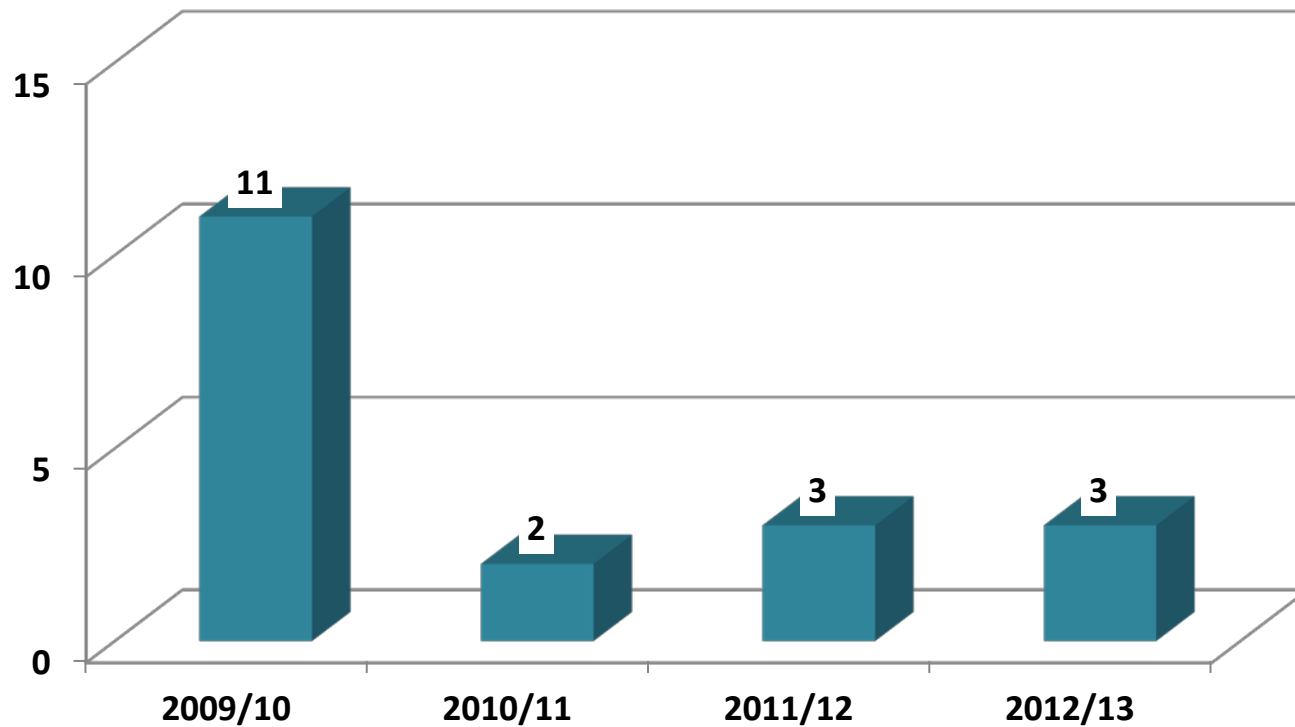

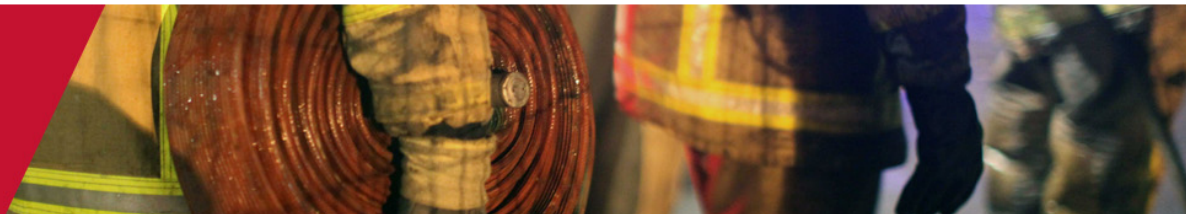
