## 1. Purpose/Executive Summary

- 1.1 This report provides an update of key information in relation to the schools within the Grantown Grammar Associated School Group (ASG) and provides useful updated links to further information in relation to these schools.
- 1.2 The primary schools in this area serve 401 pupils, Early Learning & Childcare (ELC) settings serve 60 children (60 in Local Authority settings as at September Census), with the secondary school serving 362 young people.

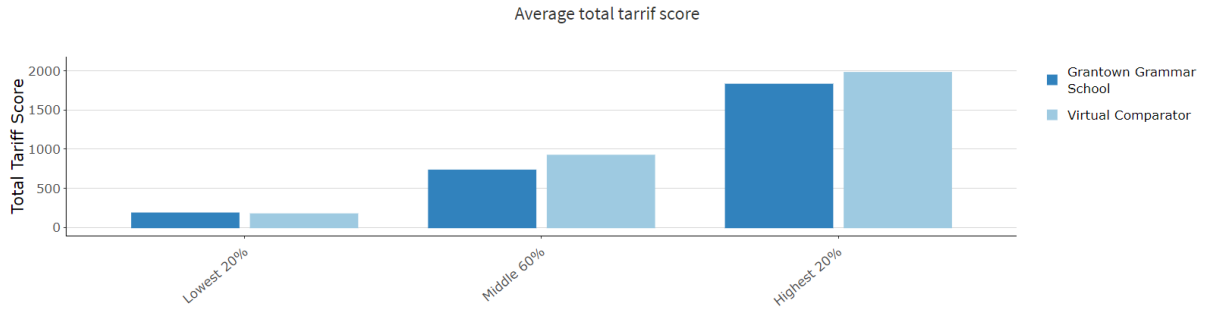

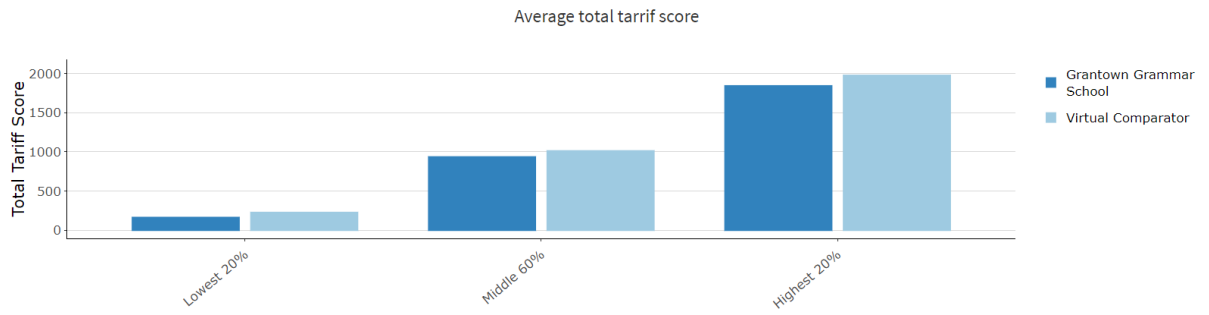

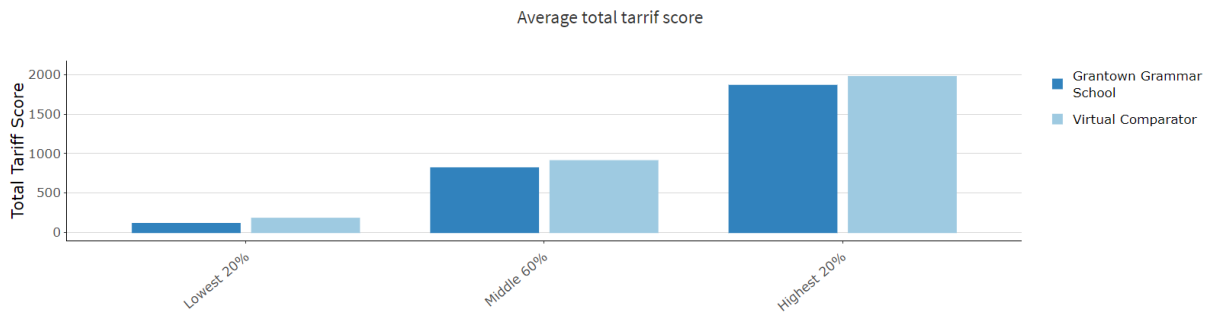
