Partnership Development Team Quarterly Update

Summary

The paper summarises the Partnership Development Team quarterly progress and updated milestones to February 2025.

The Board is asked to:

1. Background

1.1 As agreed by the Board at the September 2023 meeting, an update on the Partnership Development Teams' progress will be provided as a standing agenda item on a quarterly basis.

2. Quarterly Update

- 2.1 The work of the team to February 2025 has focussed on: Community Partnerships
 - Priority Action Trackers workshops organised February 2025 to review Priorities and Actions (Badenoch & Strathspey, Mid Ross). Further workshops to be arranged March/April 2025 (Nairn & Nairnshire, Caithness, Inverness). Attended workshops January/February 2025 (Sutherland)
 - Quarterly meetings supported delivery across the network, all nine Community Partnership meetings took place between November 2024 and January 2025.
 - Community Planning & Community Partnerships: Guidance and Toolkit finalised
 includes templates for Terms of Reference, Communications Plan and Role
 Descriptors
 - Secretariat support template drafted piloting with Inverness Community Partnership February/March 2025
 - Community Planning Partnerships Plan template drafted data section to be developed February 2025 prior to circulation with Community Partnerships

- Invitation to Community Partnerships for representatives to join Delivery Groups drafted and to be circulated – Mental Health and Wellbeing, Poverty Reduction, Community Safety and Resilience
- Partnership Coordinating Group meeting took place, online, December 2024 with HOIP focus. In person meeting organised March 2025 with Housing, Community Wealth Building and Data focus
- 2.2 Highland Community Planning Partnership
 - Improvement Service's National Community Planning Self-Assessment -0 Highland report received, to be circulated to the Board ahead of the April workshop
 - Supporting the establishment of two short life working groups as part of the HOIP Delivery Plan (Health Inequalities and Natural Capital)

 - Senior Officers to undertake full review of Strategic Risk Register March 2025, including review of risk appetite, risk response
 - Planning for CPP Annual Conference started 25th April 2025, Strathpeffer Pavilion

3. Scottish Community Planning Network (SCPN)

- 3.1 The 2024-2025 Programme for Government aims to eradicate child poverty and enhance family wellbeing and public services. It plans to work with partners to introduce local flexibility in budget and service reconfiguration, adopting a whole family approach as part of the national public sector reform. Community planning, supported by the Verity House Agreement, is crucial for aligning local resources, focusing on prevention, early intervention, and achieving shared priorities.
- An invitation was sent to the SCPN for a representative to join a cross-sector group, 3.2 which includes leaders from various sectors like government, local authorities, police, fire, health, and the third sector. This group aims to propose solutions by spring 2025 to improve community planning for whole family support. The Partnership Development Manager has joined this group, presenting an exciting opportunity to collaborate across Scotland to enhance community planning and support families in need.
- 3.3 The first meeting of the community planning group occurred in January 2025, with the next meeting scheduled for February 2025. The group is expected to drive and oversee changes, with members or smaller clusters taking actions between meetings. This group will work alongside two others focusing on funding flexibility, accountability, policy simplification, and data sharing, addressing systemic barriers to effective community planning.
